“Property owner and person(s) who received 9 points or more and lost lake privileges shall take and pass a written, open book test with 80% accuracy or better before lake privileges will be restored.”

You are receiving this open book test because, as a property owner, you had your lake privileges suspended. Before you can register your watercraft for 2008, you must complete and return this test to the Association office.

This is an open book test that covers the rules and regulations of the Lake Lotawana Association. By reading the rules, you can find the answers to every question. It is possible to pass this test with 100% accuracy. You will also be better informed and prepared to safely use the lake. Please answer every question so it is legible.

The rules require that existing watercraft be registered by May 1, 2008. The test must be returned to the Association office no later than April 15, 2008 so there is time to determine your results.
